

# Dynamic Therapeutic Formulary Drug List

The Express Scripts Canada Dynamic Therapeutic Formulary (DTF) is designed to encourage the use of clinically-sound and cost-effective medications for specific medical conditions. All medications listed on Tier 1 are preferred and will be covered at a higher level of reimbursement. Medications on Tier 2 are usually higher cost but don't offer any additional clinical or safety advantage when compared to medications on Tier 1, so they will be covered at a lower level of reimbursement. Check your benefit information to determine which drugs are included in your plan.

The following is a list of the most commonly prescribed medications.

1. Brand-name drugs are listed in **UPPERCASE** letters.
2. Generic drugs are listed in **lowercase** letters.
